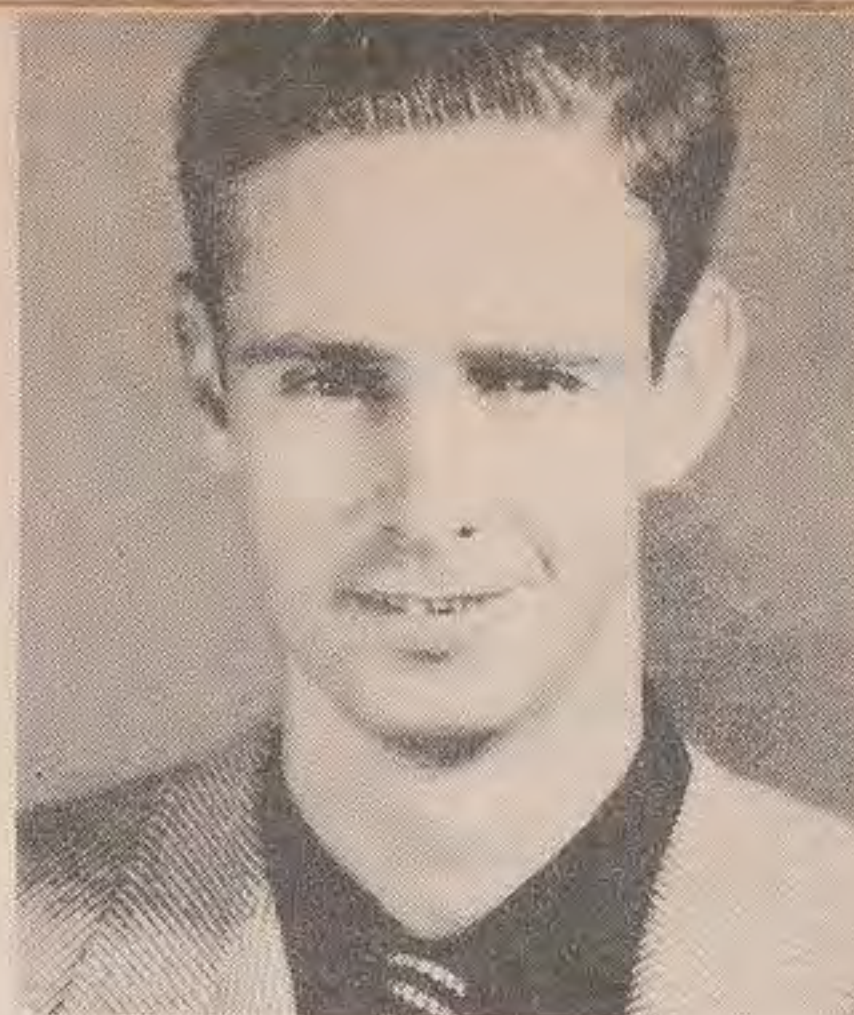
**BOWEN, JACK**
