

#### CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS of the 63rd infantry division association

#### Constitution

ARTICLE I. NAME. The name of this organization shall be 63RD INFANTRY DIVISION ASSOCIATION.

<u>ARTICLE II</u>. <u>PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of this association shall be to accumulate, hold, manage and disburse funds for the morale and welfare of the members of the 63rd Infantry Division Association.

ARTICLE III. ACCUMULATION OF FUNDS. The funds referred to above shall be accumulated through periodic assessment of the members of this association and by such other means as may be approved by the Board of Governors.

<u>ARTICLE IV.</u> <u>MEMBERSHIP</u>. The membership of the association shall consist of those commissioned and warrant officers who have been or are presently or shall hereafter become members of the 63rd Infantry Division, USAR. The membership dues shall be established annually by the Board of Governors.

<u>ARTICLE V.</u> <u>GOVERNING BOARD</u>. The governing board of the association shall consist of members of the association. It shall consist of twelve members and they shall be known as the Board of Governors.

ARTICLE VI. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS. The Board of Governors shall be elected for a term of two (2) years by the Association members with six (6) members being elected each year; of the twelve (12) members elected in 1967, as determined by lot, six (6) shall serve for 1 year and six (6) shall serve for two (2) years.

ARTICLE VII. FUND CUSTODIAN. The management of the funds shall be entrusted to the Fund Custodian, who shall be a member of the Association. The Fund Custodian shall be charged with the duty of accumulating, holding, managing and disbursing any and all funds entrusted to his care and shall maintain accurate records of all transactions involving the funds entrusted to his care.

ARTICLE VIII. APPOINTMENT OF THE FUND CUSTODIAN. The Fund Custodian shall be elected by the Board of Governors.

<u>ARTICLE IX</u>. <u>CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT</u>. This Consitiution may be amended by secret written ballot by a majority vote of the membership voting.

ARTICLE X. EFFECTIVE DATE OF CONSTITUTION. This Constitution shall become effective upon approval of the Board of Governors and ratification by a majority of the commissioned and warrant officers of the membership voting.

ARTICLE XI. ADOPTION OF BY-LAWS. The Board of Governors shall adopt by-laws at the first meeting of the Board.

#### By-laws

### BY-LAW I. THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS.

SECTION I. The Board of Governors shall not incur any debt or liability exceeding the net assets of the Association.

#### BY-LAW II. OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES.

SECTION 1. The members of the Board of Governors shall, at a regularly-scheduled meeting, elect one of their number to serve as President of the Board, and one member of the Association to serve as Fund Custodian. The term of office shall be one year.

SECTION 2. The President shall conduct and preside at all meetings of the Board and over any meeting of the Association that may be held.

SECTION 3. The President shall appoint from time to time members of the Association to such committees as he shall deem necessary to conduct the business of the Association.

SECTION 4. The Fund Custodian shall be the Recorder.

SECTION 5. The Fund Custodian shall at each meeting render a report as to the financial condition of the Association unless such report shall be dispensed with by motion.

SECTION 6. Contracts and other formal documents shall be signed by the President and the Fund Custodian.

#### BY-LAW III. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS.

SECTION 1. Meetings of the Board of Governors shall be held at the call of the President, but not less frequently than four times each calendar year.

SECTION 2. The President shall give at least seven days notice to each and every member of the Board of the fact that a meeting of the Board is called and shall state the time, place and date of the meeting.

SECTION 3. Three members present shall constitute a quorum for the conduct of any business of the Board.

#### BY-LAW IV. ORDER OF BUSINESS.

The order of business for the Board shall be:

- a. Roll call.
- b. Minutes of the previous meeting.
- c. Reports of officers and committees.
- d. Unfinished business.
- e. New business.

#### BY-LAW V. AMENDMENT OF BY-LAWS.

These and any by-laws may be amended at any meeting of the Board by affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Board voting.






