



BOARD OF GOVERNORS- Activity Report

Under the leadership of COL Tommy R. Gilliam, President for 1975-1976, the Board of Governors has met quarterly to conduct such business as may come before the Board and to further the objectives of the U.S.Army Reserve Program.

The Board considered several problem areas of concern relating to proposed changes in the method of furnishing rations to the USAR troop units for week-end drill periods and related matters. In part, because of inquiries made by this Association, proposed changes have not been implemented.

Several discussions were directed towards a Medal of Honor program which could be supported by the Association. It is noted a program has already been established in Northern California.


Ways and means by which the memorabilia of the 63d Infantry Division and its organizational units might best be preserved has been a matter of top priority.





THE CREST

SHIELD: Or, a bend gules between in chief an eagle close of the same ducally crowned and gorged with a collar of the first charged with a Lorraine cross of the second and in base a fusil of the like.

SYMBOLISM

The regiment was organized in 1917 by transfer of men from the 7th. It was a part of the 5th Division, indicated in the arms by the red diamond. The baptism of fire was the taking of Frapelle east of St. Die in the Vosges in the Lorraine. The red bend occurs in the arms of Lorraine. The regiment was in the heavy work at St. Mihiel; this is recalled by the eagle, the device of St. Mihiel.




