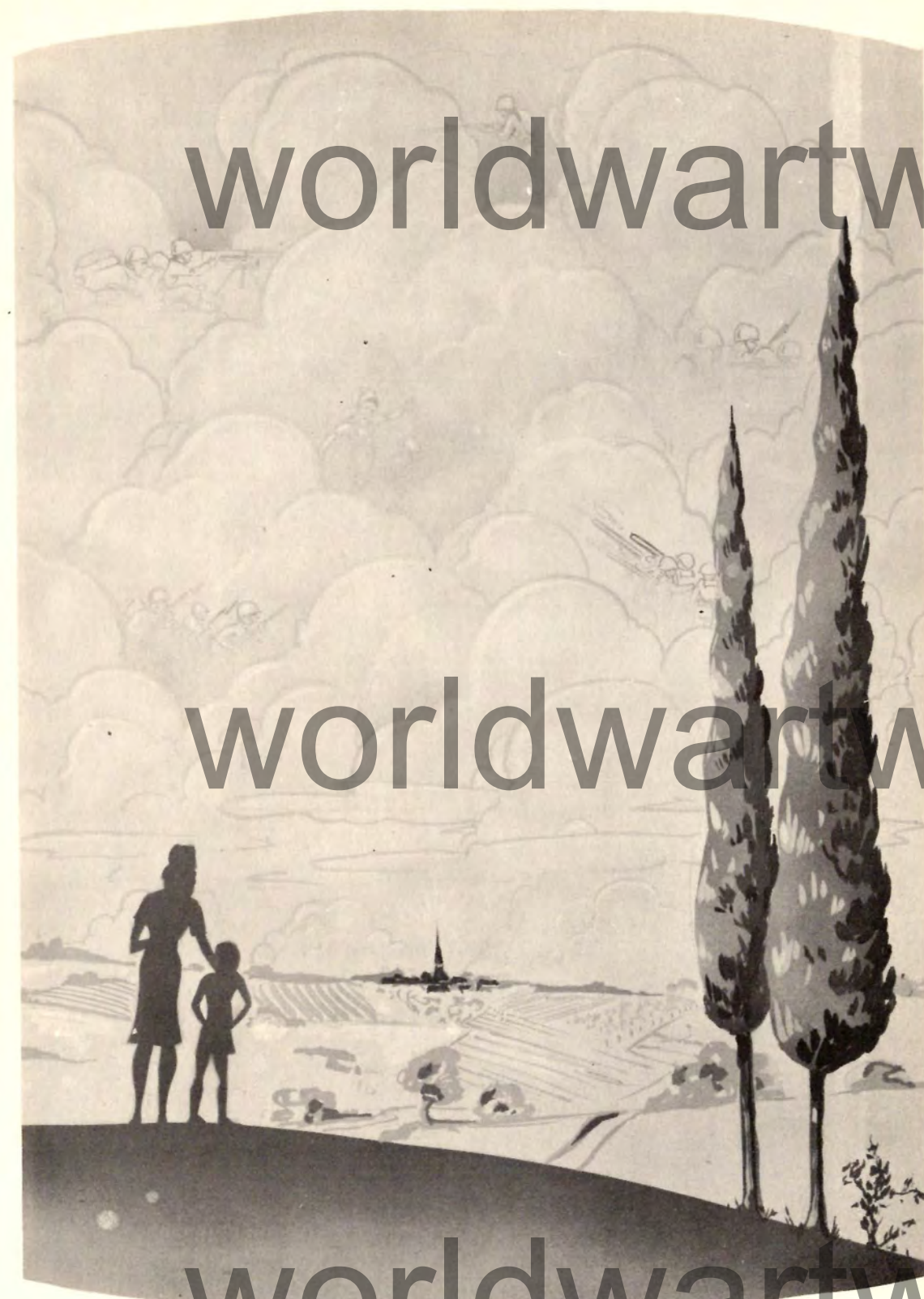

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FOREWORD

The members of the Coleman-Brinkley Post of the Veterans of Foreign Wars take pleasure in presenting this book to the citizens of our Bath County. It has been published with the hope that it will be a lasting tribute to those men who gave their lives in World War II, and that it will also give much pleasure to those men and women from Bath County who so proudly fought hand in hand defending the rights of free men everywhere.

The members of the editorial staff worked for six months collecting pictures and data for this book, with the hope that it could be made as complete as possible. However it is to be regretted that many pictures were found to be unavailable and a comparatively small percentage of veterans could not be contacted.

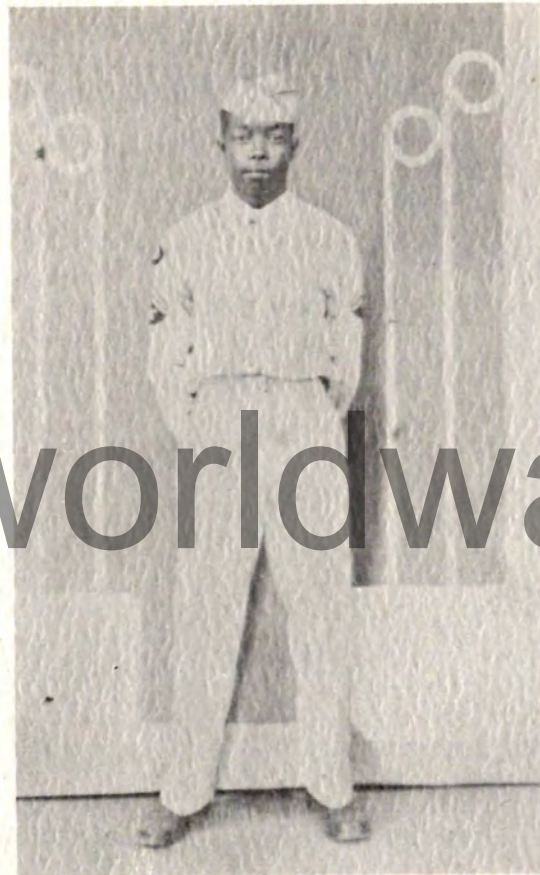
The material for this book was compiled through individual letters to each veteran, and through personal calls for information by members of the V. F. W. Additional information was also requested through various advertising mediums. Despite these efforts, it was found impossible to obtain a picture and record of everyone within a reasonable length of time. Other than the pictures necessarily omitted, and any errors beyond our control, we feel that the book represents a good pictorial history of Bath Countians in World War II.

As a matter of record, from a total population of 7,192 people, Bath County had 968 men and women in uniform. Of this number 45 gave their lives for their country. While these figures are not official, they are approximately correct and represent an unusually high percentage of the total in service and men lost.

There are today those who believe that the "ghost of the springs" still walks, and it is probable that more people enjoy these waters now than were benefitted by them at the turn of the 18th Century, when this resort was in its hey-day.

The present Bath County Court House was constructed in 1914. It carries a historical heritage. The first Bath County Court was held at the home of Mrs. Lewis, widow of John Lewis, on May 10, 1791, approximately one year after the country was organized. This court and subsequent adjournments thereof arranged for the construction of the building to house the majesty of the law. In May, 1795, it was ordered that the High Sheriff pay three dollars for acceptable plans for a 30 x 20 two-story building, to be located on the bank above the Warm Springs Hotel. This building was completed and accepted by the Commissioners in November, 1796. This building was adequate for a number of years, at which time the Commissioners ordered the construction of a "modern brick building" located where the Warm Springs Inn is now located, and it served as the county seat until the construction of a brick building on the present site, which was destroyed by fire in 1913 and was the immediate successor of the present Court House.



The Homestead Hotel at Hot Springs, Virginia, is by far the largest business within the confines of the county and, like Bath County itself, has an unbroken record of contribution to the welfare of the people.

The first inn was built near the present site before the Revolutionary War, but it was not until about 1830 that this hostelry came into prominence as a fashionable spa.

The history of this hotel is of course a progressive one, and it is a far cry from the first inn erected to house the overflow of guests who were constantly imposing themselves upon the gracious host in the 1700's, to the present 500 room structure and the adjacent cottages.

During World War II the Homestead gladly assumed its place in the national defense setup and housed the Japanese Diplomatic Corp during their period of internment, a task which, though distasteful, was performed with all the graciousness which the staff, loyal to American traditions, could muster for their enemies, hoping that the Japs would reciprocate to Joseph Grew, who was a friend of many Homestead employees, and his staff. A little later on, it was the privilege of the Homestead to entertain the International Food Conference--this, too, as a war effort. These tasks of course were performed at the request of the State Department, and, excluding the rebuilding period after a disastrous fire in 1901, were the only interruptions of the operation of this famous resort as the gathering place for famous people from all over the world for almost two centuries.

Today, the Homestead organization consists of approximately 1000 employees, most of whom are residents of Bath County and many of whom are veterans of World Wars I and II.

CIVILIAN EFFORTS IN WORLD WAR II
As Sponsored by the Bath County Civilian Defense Council

Upon the instructions of the Governor of Virginia, a Civilian Defense Council was organized in Bath County in February, 1940, with Floyd S. Kay as Director and Carl J. Wallin as Coordinator. The original members of the council consisted of the Director, the Coordinator, Charles C. Helms, C. Edward Bonner, Rev. J. T. McCutchan, George L. Taylor, Charles Withrow, and Ernest S. Cleek.

The original purpose of the council as outlined by a memorandum from the Governor was to provide a protective force in case of enemy action and to sponsor an inspirational and educational program designed to inform the people as to their proper function in times of national stress.

Mr. Wallin assumed active charge of the organization and set up the necessary protective force, i. e. Air Raid Wardens, Civilian Police, etc., etc., and designed a Control Center for the entire county under the management of Ivar Gram of the Homestead Garage.

The Hot Springs Nursing Association, under the supervision of Miss Gertrude Wilson, was charged with the First Aid program and within a few months turned out thirty-three white graduates of the required course and thirteen colored graduates.

When Mr. Wallin was called to the Armed Services, Ernest S. Cleek assumed his duties as Coordinator and the Council was then enlarged to include at least one member from every civic organization and body politics within the confines of the county. This revamped Council as it was then organized consisted of the following members:

This Council saw the war problem in this community one of service rather than as one of protection, and though the protective angle was not subordinated in any manner, the Council as a whole felt its service to the community could best be exemplified by taking over and properly coordinating all the activities which might ordinarily be handled by the several groups as individuals.



Windy Cove Church, located on the east side of Warm Springs Mountain near the historical Blowing Cave, has probably the longest continuous history of any place of worship west of the Blue Ridge. Unauthenticated records show that religious services were held near the site of this church, at Fort Dickinson, as early as 1747. Authentic history shows that formal church was in operation near the present site of the church as early as 1750.

The original structure, built of logs and containing a large fireplace, stood on the old Craighead Farm, was constructed about 1749. Reference to contemporary data shows that a new roof was ordered for this structure at a cost of \$10 in the year 1756 and that one William Gillespie was denied the price because the roof did not turn water and snow. Incidentally, William Gillespie was one of the first elders of the Windy Cove Church.

A second church was built in 1776 and this was succeeded in 1837 by the present brick building, plus such constructions as have been found necessary to keep the edifice adequate for the enlarging congregation.

The Council immediately assumed responsibility for providing recreation for soldiers, for providing transportation for those who were stranded, and for rendering temporary aid to soldiers' families until the Red Cross could make investigation and act.

During the internment of the Japanese Diplomatic Corps at the Homestead Hotel, this Council provided recreation facilities for the Border Patrol and for the FBI operatives who were charged with the protection of these Aliens.

When the Homestead was taken over by the United Nations Food Conference, approximately 110 soldiers were stationed here and the Council undertook to provide club rooms and entertainment for them. Arrangements were made for facilities for this purpose in the parish house of the Shrine of the Sacred Heart, which was donated by Father Richard B. Washington. The Council provided reading material, stationery, and nightly entertainment with bi-weekly dances for all the enlisted men - this at a cost of about \$560.00.

The Council further undertook "send-offs" for every contingent of Bath County boys who were inducted in the Armed Service. The usual procedure was to have our local band, under the direction of Robert Maddaford, present. In addition, each soldier was provided with a breakfast and a packed lunch, as well as a kit consisting of handkerchiefs, tooth paste, shaving materials, etc. This single activity has been applied in about 540 individual cases at a cost of something over \$1,000.00.

In all these activities the support of the community was most generous and in the final analysis the effectiveness in any organization must be gauged by the financial support offered it by those who know its functions.

It is interesting to note that in the history of this Council no organized campaign was ever attempted to raise funds for any purpose and yet this Council was adequately provided for by individual and spontaneous donations supplemented by a few programs which it put on for the entertainment and enlightenment of the people.

From the protective angle, it is felt that this Council has a unique record and a tabulation of reports from the Air Raid Wardens, Auxiliary Police, etc., etc., following all air raid tests discloses that over 80% of the entire membership of this protective force were on the job. The make-up of the protective force consists of:

All in all, those who were charged with the administration of the affairs of this Council have every reason to believe that the people of this community were war conscious and were ready at all times to meet any demands made on them.
