He was inducted into the United States Army at St. Joseph, Missouri, April 4, 1941. He received his basic training with the 110th Medical Regiment with the 35th division at Camp Robinson, Little Rock, Arkansas. He took part in the 6 weeks maneuvers in the South while stationed at that place.

On December 20, 1941 he was sent to the west coast, arriving at Ft. Ord, California on Christmas Eve. He was a driver in the Ambulance Corps and was transferred to the 673rd Medical Collecting Company. After arriving on the West Coast, his work extended from Oceanside, California, in Southern California, to Eureka, California, in the northern part of that state.

On October 25, 1943 he entered the Hammond General Hospital at Modesta, California, where he died January 24, 1944 following an operation for infected kidney. He was born January 2, 1917. He was employed at Swift and Company, St. Joseph when he went into the army. Wilton was an only child.

He received the Good Conduct Medal and presidential citation. He was chapel organist for the 110th Medical Regiment while serving with that regiment, and was organist at many different stations where he stayed.

He did very extensive and strenuous driving on the West Coast during the black out times there, often being required to drive over mountain roads in rain at night with out lights.
