Two action items resulted from our meeting.


The first is consensus that our Association should be supporting the establishment of the National US Army Museum which is under construction near Washington DC. To do this a web page has been established for donations on behalf of the 63rd Infantry Division Association (USAR) at which you can make a donation directly to the Army Historical Foundation, the non-profit raising the funds to build the museum. Our goal is to raise a minimum of \$2,500 which will give our association recognition on the Veterans Donor Wall in the "Veterans Hall" which is a multi-purpose space for veterans to host reunions, meetings, dinners, and official functions in a patriotic atmosphere. The second is to find a way to get greater participation in the Annual Meeting. The challenge is that our membership is very disbursed. There is a natural concentration in Southern California. Provisions are made in the By-Laws for the regional chapters to use "The Blade" to communicate with it's members and the regional chapter would have the benefits of our non-profit status. If your interested in the regional chapter effort please contact me and I'll work to get you connected with those who have a similar interest.

I'm hopeful that by next year we will be announcing that there will be more than one "Annual Meeting" and that more of us can have the opportunity to renew old friendships with those who we served with. For now, the next Annual Meeting in Southern California will be held on 28 April 2019, which is the last Sunday in April.

52nd Annual Meeting of the 63rd Infantry Division Association USAR

2018 Annual Meeting Business Meeting Minutes by Secretary COL WISENBAKER

The 63rd Infantry Division USAR Association annual meeting was held on 29 April 2018 at the Hotel Fullerton located in Fullerton California. The meeting began at 1100 hours in the Crystal Room of the hotel with a social hour during which attendees had an opportunity to renew acquaintances with others in attendance.

Following the social hour, President BG Chuck Ebner opened the meeting at 1215 hours, with the Pledge of Allegiance lead by CSM Robi Roberson and an Invocation by COL (CH) Don Forden. The meeting was then recessed for the service of the luncheon buffet.

The meeting was reconvened at 1310 hours by BG Ebner. He explained to the attendees that once again the Board of Directors has determined that rather than have a "guest speaker" we would once again call on our members to introduce themselves and to tell the other members something about themselves, their service in the USAR, the Army or what they have been doing since leaving the Army Reserve. He started by introducing our first member, CSM Roberson. CSM Roberson introduced the Nakamura family, whose son, Paul Jr, lost his life in the Iraq war and has been honored by having the headquarters building for the 79th Theater Support Command named after him. Following this introduction the remaining members in attendance addressed the meeting.

At 1435 hours, COL Ben Colcol, the Membership Chairman introduced two new members, COL Bob Allen, and CSM Michael Crespo. Following the introduction BG Ebner make a presentation on the opportunity that our association has to be a part of the National Museum of the US Army now being constructed at Ft. Belvoir, VA. He asked for the memberships support in our efforts to raise \$2,500 so that

Following the presentation COL Jim Wisenbaker conducted the official business part of the meeting by calling for nominations for Board Membership. He explained that there were 5 Executive Board positions open for election this year and that Board Members COL Lydia Collins, CSM Robert Roberson and COL Rick Garza are willing to serve for an additional two year term on the board. He also explained that Board Member CSM Greenberg and SFC Davis have chosen not to seek re-appointment to the board. He then called for nominations from the floor. No other nominations were made from the floor. Following a motion by MG Bob Lame the membership affirmed by a voice vote the s re-election of , Collins, Roberson, and Garza

Following the election BG Ebner pointed out to the membership the difficulty in finding members who were willing to serve on the 11 person Executive Board and suggested that the Board study this issue and return next year with a recommendation to reduce the size of the Executive Board. With that the business portion of the meeting was concluded.

LTC Bev Houghton conducted the Raffle assisted by granddaughter Ryley Bryson. COL (CH) Don Forden offered a Benediction and President BG Ebner then closed formal meeting at 1445 Hours reminding those in attendance that next year's meeting will be on Sunday 28 April 2019.

Michael Albert Ewens

MARCH 13, 1939 – MAY 16, 2018



Michael A. Ewens reported to his final duty station on 16 May 2018, upon orders from his highest commander. He always obeyed orders from those appointed above him. Mike passed away at age 79, following a brave battle with cancer.

Born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on 13 March 1939 to Bud and Meta Ewens, Michael laid out his life from the very beginning as a young man. He was greatly influenced while reading Theodore Roosevelt's "African Game Trails" at an early age and became a devoted admirer of our 26th U.S. President. His goal was to follow Teddy as a cowboy, policeman, Army officer, National Park staff, environmentalist, conservationist, educator, big game hunter and climber of mountains. All of Roosevelt's writings remained a creed of behavior for Mike's entire life, as he accomplished everything he set out to do.

Michael was deeply involved in Boy Scouting for over 60 years – from childhood into adulthood, leading his two sons. He has passionately volunteered with the American Red Cross for 60+ years – as a boy assisting his mother and grandmother during World War II and for decades as a CPR/First Aid Instructor, Disaster Preparedness/ Emergency Response Administrator and Mass Care Shelter Manager. He retired as a U.S. Army Colonel after 31 years, having served tours in Vietnam, Cold War Germany, Kuwait, Iraq, Saudi Arabia and many stints at the Pentagon. Professor Mike enthusiastically taught business courses at Ventura College for 34 years, continuing to receive compliments from prior students. Throughout his life, he had been a Reserve Police Officer, a National Park Ranger in the Grand Tetons of Wyoming, a Safety Manager in the off-shore oil industry, a Social Services Director for the Salvation Army, a Manpower Programs Chief with County Government, and an active member of his church Our Lady of the Assumption, as a Eucharistic Minister. Whatever the endeavor, Michael fully committed and shared himself with compassion, dedication, and a missionary heart.

The word Outdoorsman doesn't do Mike justice ... he needed to be outside appreciating "God's Country". He eagerly enjoyed hunting, fishing, hiking, and camping all over the Mountain West while owning and operating a ranch in northern New Mexico.

Michael Ewens always filled the room with his presence. He was larger than life with a vibrant personality, easy to know and such a kind, memorable man. He definitely touched many lives, but none more than his beloved family: lifetime soulmate Col. Lydia, his sons, Scott and Matt, his brothers John and Tom, Nieces Becky and Denise, Nephew Andy, godson John & wife Amy, and all of their amazing families. He will be greatly missed by numerous cousins and countless friends.

Information regarding COL Russell Parris that we recently became aware of.....Paris, Col. Russell C.. AUS (RET)
A 45-year resident of Westminster passed away March 7, 2006, after a courageous battle with cancer. Russell was born December 6, 1925 in Buffalo, New York. He graduated from the University of Buffalo, College of Arts and Sciences with a BA degree. Russell and his wife Helen - whom he has been married to for more than 56 years - moved to Westminster in 1961. He is survived by his loving wife, Helen; his six children, Russell, Jr., Cheryl, Roger, Jim, Lee Ann and Lynnette; nine grandchildren, John, Jennifer, Heather, Blair, Danielle, Katelyn, Hunter, Zachary and Hayden; two great-grandchildren, Natalie and Marissa; sister, Sarah Cartone and brother, Joseph Paris of Buffalo, New York.
